

Save Our Southall Town Hall!



Ealing Council have made a decision to dispose of Southall Town Hall, one of Southall's last remaining public buildings, due to financial constraints but there has been no consultation with users or members of the public.

The Town Hall is used by over 10,000 residents annually, many of whom have language difficulties or face major problems accessing advice, housing or employment. Local community organisations and small businesses use this base and it will affect their survival and reduce the already very limited support available.

Tenants and users of the Town Hall have set up a group called 'Friends of Southall Town Hall', who believe the building can be run without reliance upon Ealing Council funds. We are opposed to plans that stop Southall Town Hall being open to all sections of our diverse local community.
